WHAT TO BRING & NOT BRING!

YOU NEED TO...

- Our camp site is on private property so there are **NO** national park camping fees **but** if you want to drive into the park on Sat & Sun arvo you will need to **go online before coming to camp** and pay \$12.50 for a **day vehicle pass**: <https://www.parks.sa.gov.au/parks/gawler-ranges-national-park>
- **(NO PHONE SIGNAL after MINNIPA)**

WHAT WE PROVIDE

- Long drop toilets
- Breakfasts (toast, bacon & eggs)
- Lunches (yiros, spag bog, salads)
- Teas (steak/chicken steak, salads, potatoes)
- Hot drink facilities (tea, coffee, milo)
- Sink for washing dishes.
- Sign and lights at camp turn off

WHAT YOU NEED TO BRING

- A parent/guardian if you are under 18 years old :)
- *Accommodation* - **water proof** (swag, tent, caravan)
- **Really warm bedding!** You may need **fluffy socks, track pants, jumpers & beanie to sleep in**. It gets **COLD AT NIGHT & WARMS UP DURING THE DAY**.
- Your own cutlery/plates/cups—(*we provide a washing station*)
 - have a bag to store them at the camp rather than your sleeping area. (less walking)
 - also bringing your own tea towel can be handy.
- **Water (2L > per person per day = *more than 6L/person*)!**
- Camping chair and torch
- Snacks/marshmallows for toasting if you want
- **Warm clothes for night and rain jacket!**
- **Walking clothes/shoes for hiking**
- Own toilet / shower if you want
- Bring your **musical instruments** if you want to join with our band. We believe in having a go so everyone will fit in no matter what their ability!

TRAVELING OUT THERE

Heidi will be at the **Minnipa shop** at **3:30pm** arvo if anyone would like an escort out to the camp, especially if you are feeling unsure about where to go.

Those travelling on your own... Or unfamiliar...

Follow the **brown Gawler Ranges National Park signs** out of **Minnipa**. When you get to **Bachelors Corner** (green sign) there is a **white Gawler Ranges National Park sign** as you slightly veer **right** onto **Yardea Road**.

As you go you will have sheds, trucks, silos and shuttles in the paddock on your left. **From Bachelors Corner** it will be **12.7km till the camp turn off**. You will also go over **2 cattle grids** and the **last 5km is corrugated**.
